

Understanding Daniel's Last Seven (Daniel 9:27)

- One Week (of years) is divided into two parts of $3\frac{1}{2} + 3\frac{1}{2}$ years each

- The **first half of the week** will be when Antichrist confirms the covenant and the Jewish people are permitted to restart sacrifices and offerings.

-The **second half of the week** is when Antichrist sets himself up as god in the rebuilt Jewish Temple and fulfills what Daniel and Jesus said about "The Abomination of Desolations" (cf. Dan 12:11; Matt 24:15)

-That "midst of the week" is half the seven (half a week). Besides this, it has been expressed in 3 different ways in various Scriptures, but they all add up to $3\frac{1}{2}$ years:

1260 Days = (cf Rev 11:3; 12:6)

Three and half years = (How we say it in today's language)

Forty Two Months (Rev. 11:2, 12:6, 13:5)

Time, times and half a time ($1 + 2 + \frac{1}{2} = 3$)
(or) Time, times and the dividing of time =
(cf. Dan. 7:25; 12:7; Rev. 12:14)
